Mr George Valasoulis received his Medical Degree in 2004 from the Medical School of the University of Ioannina, Greece. In 2014, he completed his PhD with Honours in Obstetrics and Gynecology - Cervical Pathology with Prof. E. Paraskevaidis at the Medical School of the University of Ioannina, and in 2018 he received his Master’s Degree in Prenatal diagnosis - Delivery - Contraception at the Medical School of the Democritus University of Thrace in Greece. In 2022 he received the Diploma in Minimal Access Surgery (D.MAS) at the World Laparoscopy Hospital, India.

From October 2018 till December 2024 he was appointed as senior Lecturer at the Midwifery Department of the School of Health Sciences at the University of Western Macedonia, Greece. His current placement is within the Academic staff of Faculty of Medicine of the School of Health Sciences of the University of Thessaly, at the Obstetrics and Gynecology Department (Assistant Professor since

1/2025), while also he is serving as Consultant Obstetrician & Gynecologist in the Obstetrics and Gynecology ward of University Hospital of Larissa, Greece.
